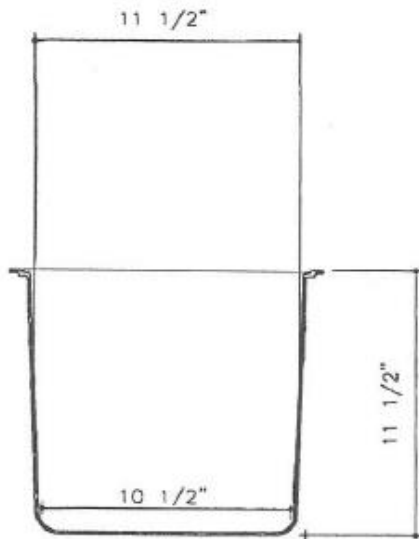

Columbarium Considerations & Guidelines

1. Columbarium niches have the opening oriented toward the side of the structure or the top (as shown). In both cases the size of the niches are the same.



LINER SIZE 1

The niche liner measures 11.5 inches at the opening and tapers to 10.5 inches toward the rear or bottom depending on the orientation. For practical purposes the unit should be considered 11 inches in depth since the opening is closed/sealed by an inserted cover plate. This sketch shows the liner oriented toward the top.

2. Please consider the size of the container for the remains and how it should fit and be placed within the niche so it can be properly sealed.

3. No more than two cremated remains may be placed in any one niche, regardless of the orientation.
4. Niche marking is restricted to only the marker provided and installed by the Lewisburg Cemetery Association. No other marking or ornamentation is allowed, whether permanent or temporary. The Lewisburg Cemetery Association reserves the right to remove any ornamentation or correct any alteration at the expense of the owner without being deemed guilty of any manner of trespass.
5. The placement of any artificial flowers or decorations, as well as any type of permanent plantings, within the columbarium beds is not permitted and these items will be removed. This ensures consistency within this garden setting and recognizes that individual personal tastes will differ. Funeral decorations are permitted but will be removed within seven days following inurnment. However, the Lewisburg Cemetery Association assumes no responsibility for the safekeeping of any floral memorial or container.
